As part of institutional process, we have collected curriculum related feedback from major stakeholders including students, parents, alumni, faculty members, and employers. Based on the input received from the feedback, we wish to put forth some recommendations that may be included in the AKTU curriculum in the next academic session 2021-22. The recommendations are summarized as follows:

1. **Common for all engineering branches:** Conduction of virtual labs is required for at least 8 practicals for easier conduction of labs during online classes.
2. **B.Tech Electrical Engineering:** A course on Electrical vehicles is required.
