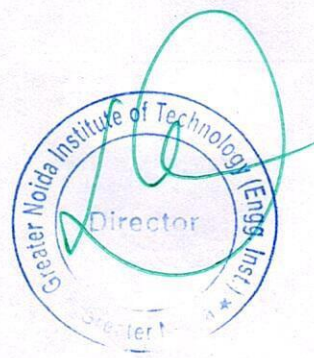
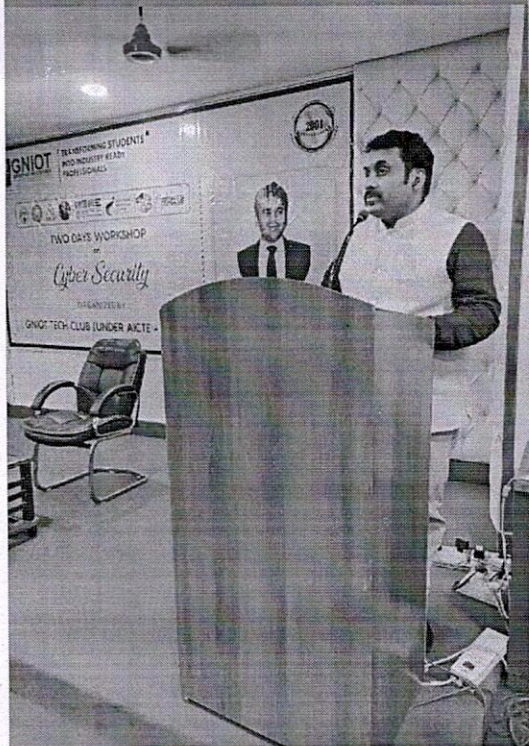
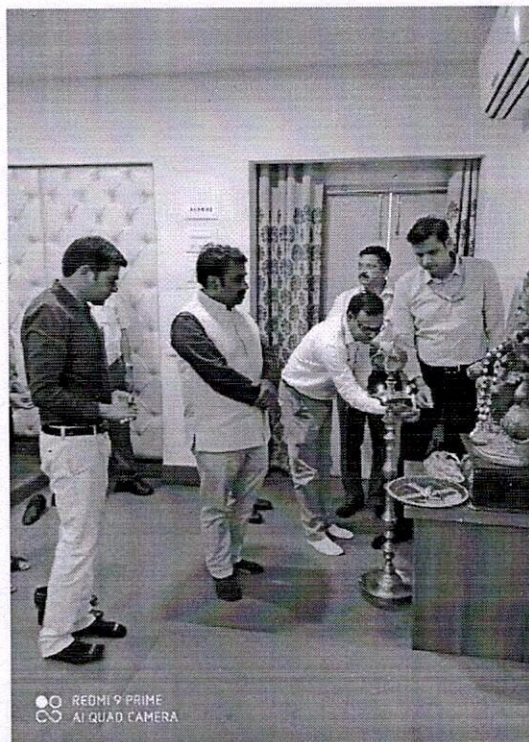


**"Cyber Security is a shared responsibility and it boils down to this: In Cyber Security, the more systems we secure, the more secure we all are."**

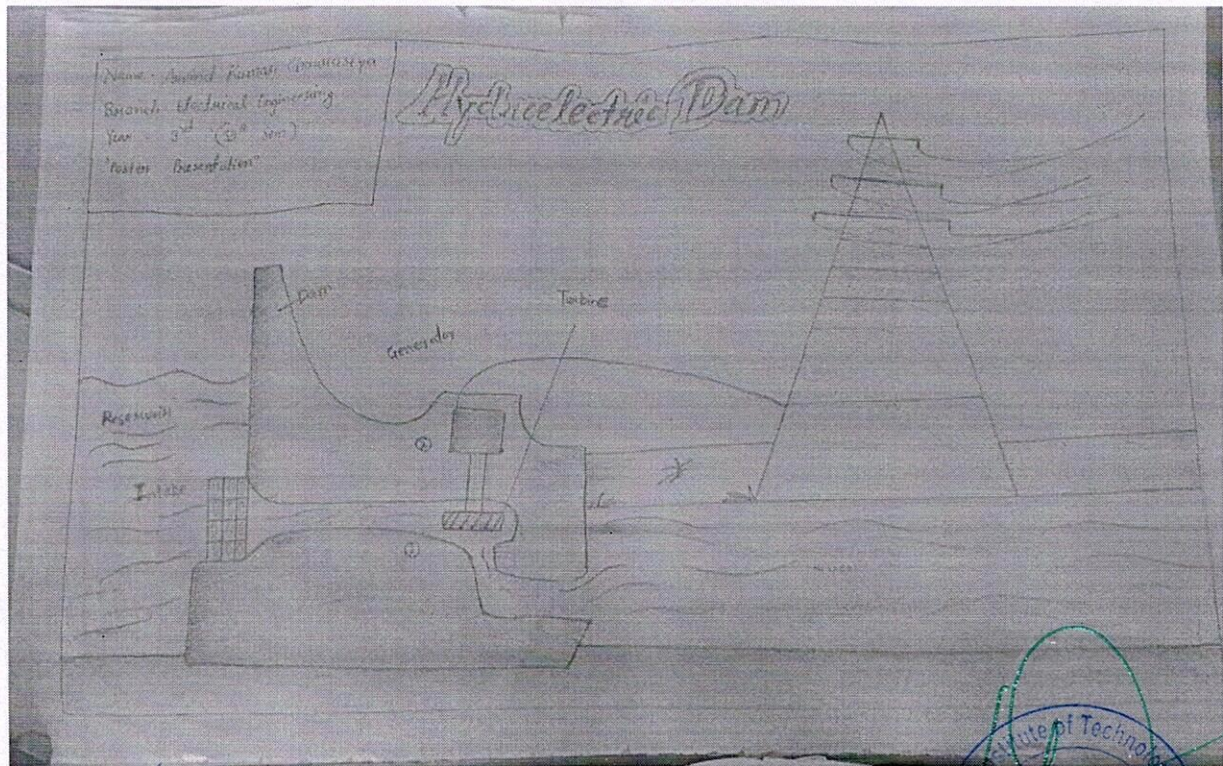
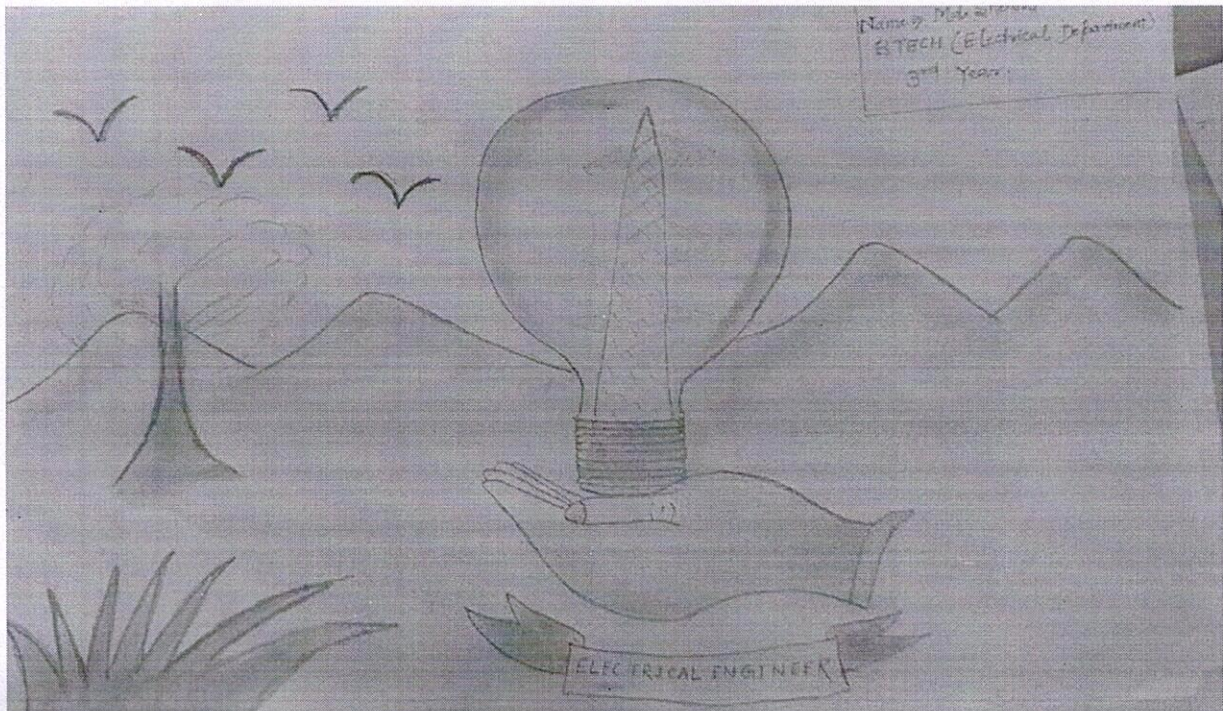


### National Energy Conservation Day, 14.12.2021










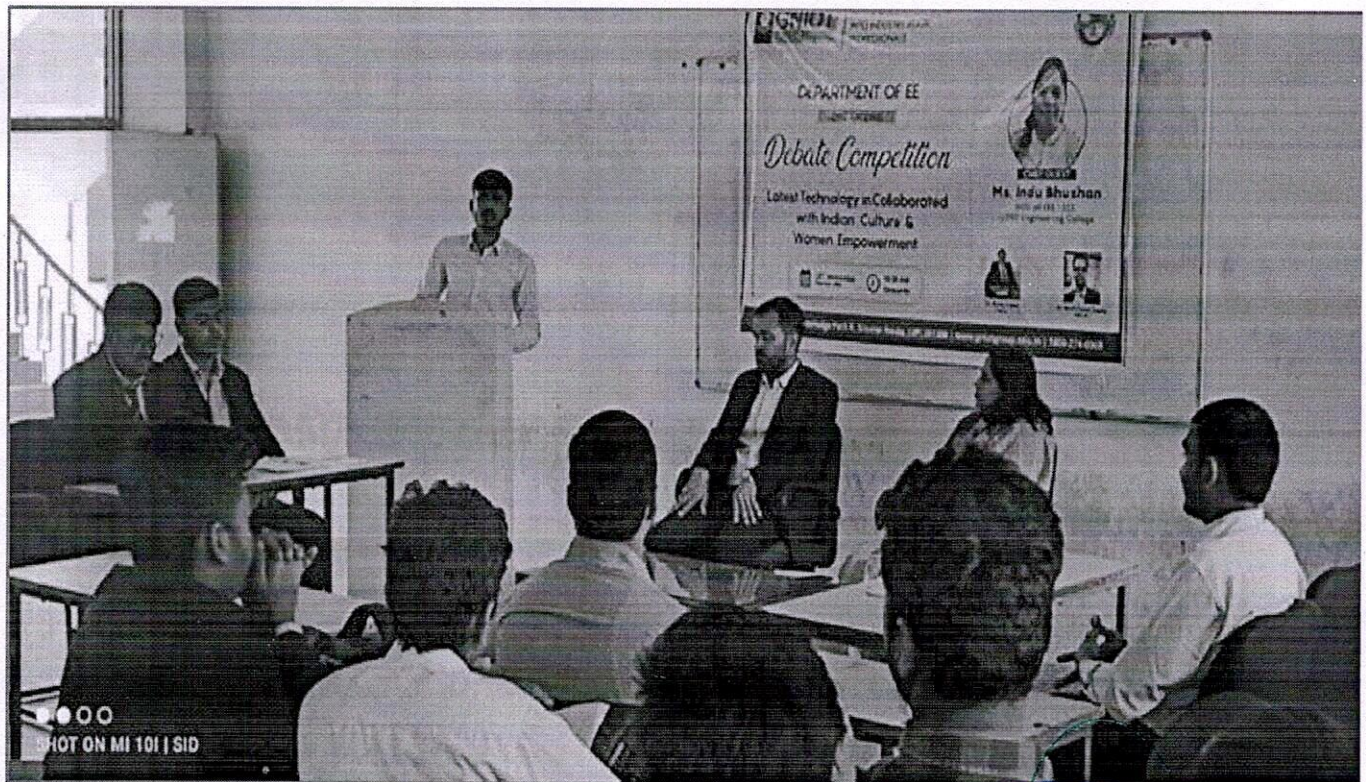
## Debate Competition
