#### **Summary Report: Dengue Prevention Awareness**


The Computer Science & Engineering Department successfully organized "Dengue Prevention Awareness" activity in the college campus on 28-09-2019. The students were made aware of the measures and practices to prevent the spread of Dengue.

The Dengue Prevention Awareness event took place on 28<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2019 at GNIOT, Gr. Noida Campus. Dr. Vishal Sharma, the speaker at the event, discussed the seriousness of dengue fever and the measures that can be taken to prevent its spread. He highlighted the symptoms of dengue fever, including high fever, severe headache, joint pain, and rash, and emphasized the importance of seeking medical attention immediately if any of these symptoms occur.Dr. Sharma also discussed how dengue fever can lead to severe complications, such as dengue haemorrhagic fever or dengue shock syndrome, which can be life-threatening. Therefore, prevention is crucial to avoid the spread of dengue fever.

He provided information on preventive measures such as eliminating breeding sites of mosquitoes by removing stagnant water around homes, using mosquito repellent, wearing protective clothing, and installing screens on windows and doors. He also stressed the importance of community involvement in dengue prevention efforts.

Dr. Vishal also discussed various aspects of dengue prevention, including how to identify and eliminate breeding sites for mosquitoes, the importance of using mosquito repellent and protective clothing, and the signs and symptoms of dengue fever. In addition to the presentations, the event included interactive activities and demonstrations that helped to reinforce the key messages about dengue prevention. The audience was engaged throughout the event, with

During the program, participants expressed their thoughts on the significance of Dengue and Malaria prevention in their community. Here are some quotes from notable individuals:




that individuals can take to maintain good hygiene. The speaker also talked about the impact of poor hygiene on health and the measures that can be taken to prevent the spread of diseases.
