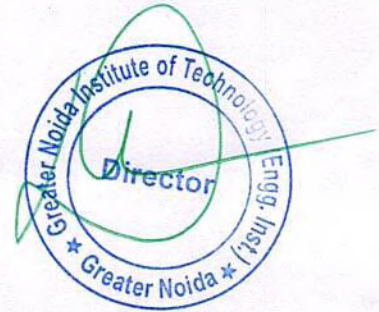

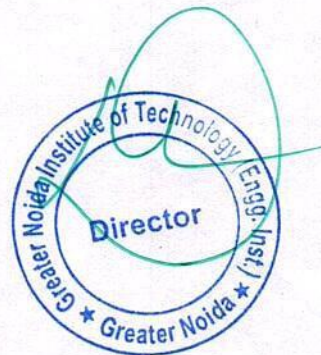
**Subject: Yoga Day Celebration at GNIOT, Greater Noida**

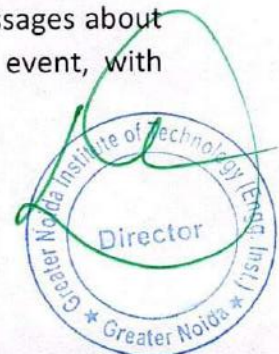
### Summary Report: Dengue Prevention Awareness

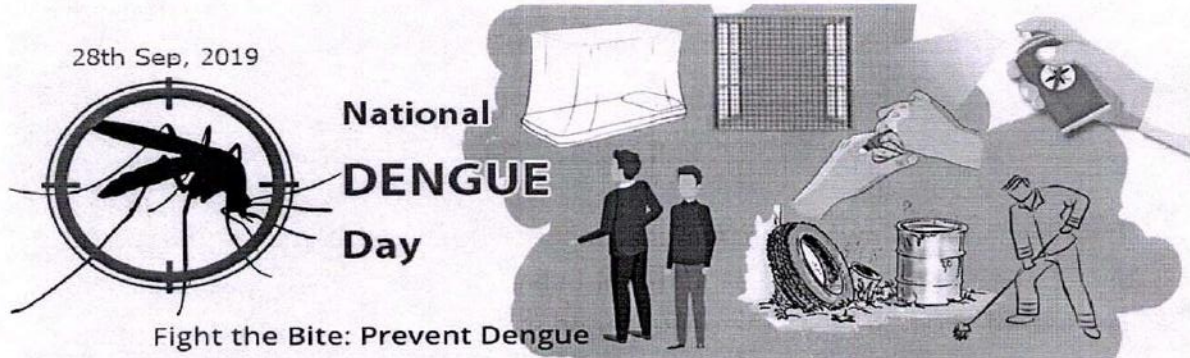
The Dengue Prevention Awareness event took place on 28<sup>th</sup> Sep, 2019 at GNIOT, Gr. Noida Campus. Dr. Vishal Sharma, the speaker at the event, discussed the seriousness of dengue fever and the measures that can be taken to prevent its spread. 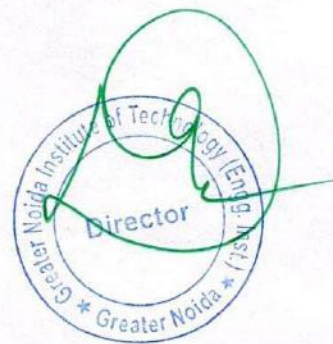

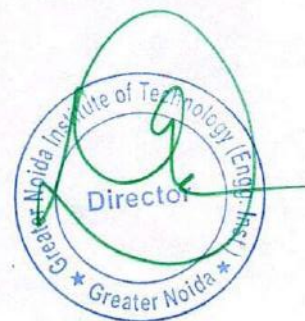

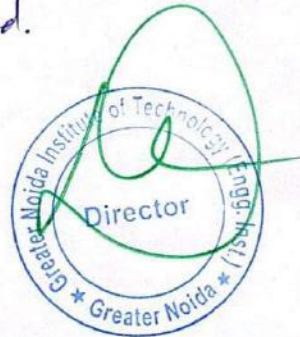

**Report on Dengue-Malaria Awareness Program Conducted by the

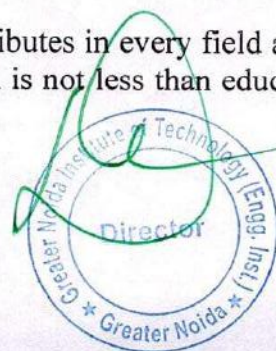
“Education is the only key to empower girls.”

Hod, IT Dr. Manoj Singhal Sir shared his views regarding the Girl Education and Hygiene and inspired students to promote it at their best.

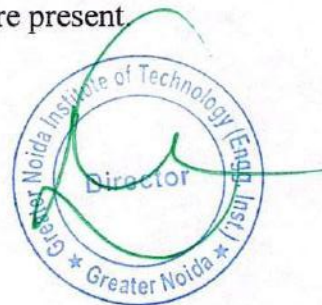
