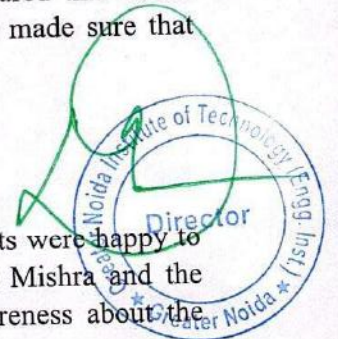


Distribution Drive:
