The motive was to explain that an educated girl contributes in every field and is a fortune for her family and country. Educating a girl is not less than educating a whole family.



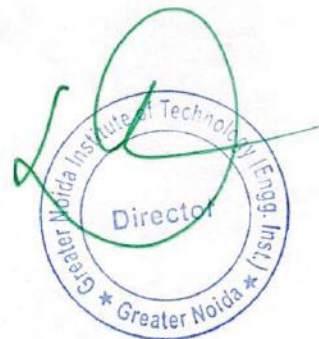
Hod, IT Dr. Manoj Singhal Sir shared his views regarding the Girl Education and Hygiene and inspired students to promote it at their best.

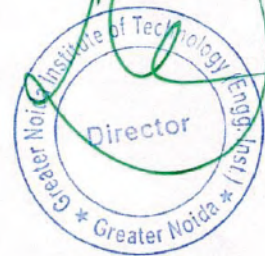
Other mentors, faculties, co-ordinators and students were present.




A report on Kite Flying (13 August, 2019)

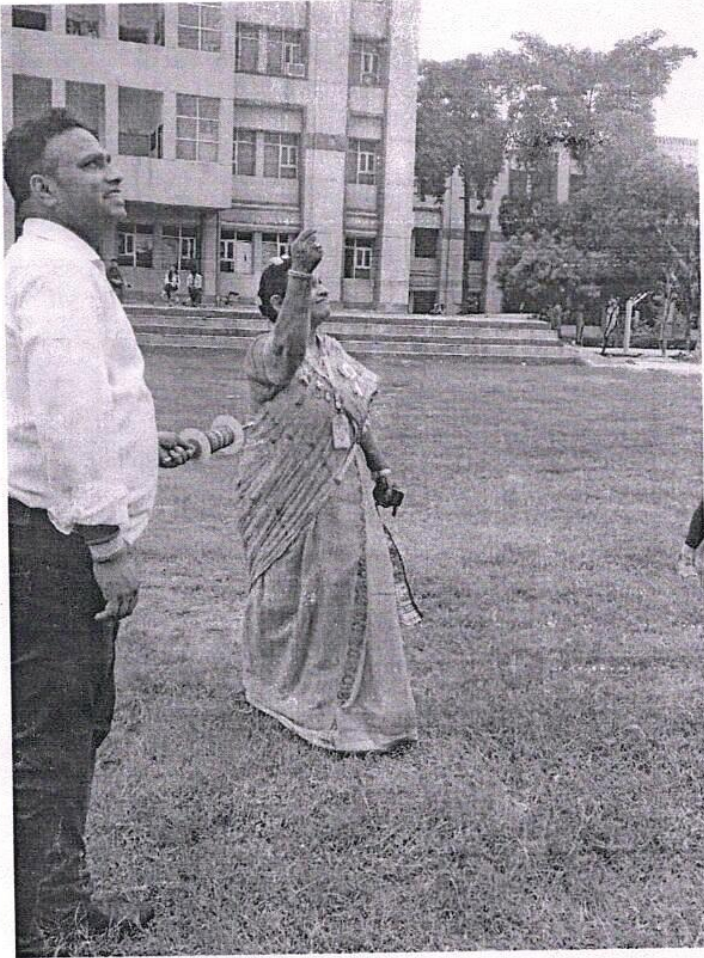
Kite-flying is an interesting tradition followed on the occasion of Independence Day in India.

Outcome of the event

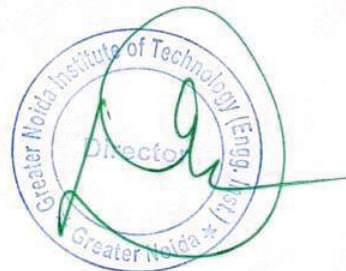
- The faculty member get connected to the Indian traditional sport, i.e., kite flying.

The Event was an interactive Question and Answer session. The session was very fruitful and interactive.

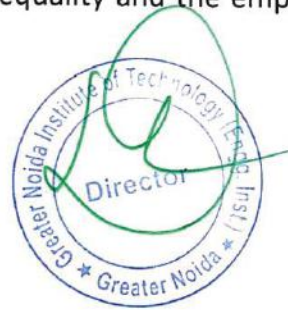

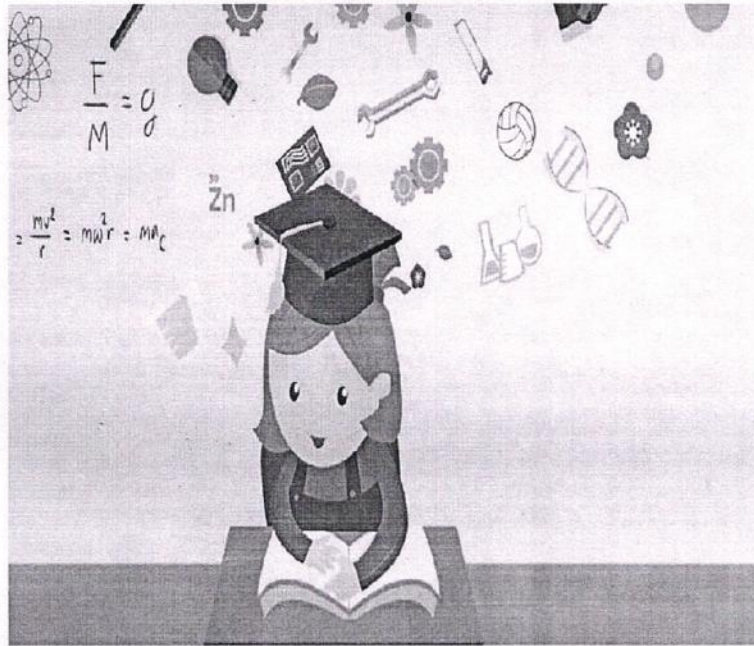
Several speakers at the occasion discussed the value of girls' education. Some famous people have said the following:

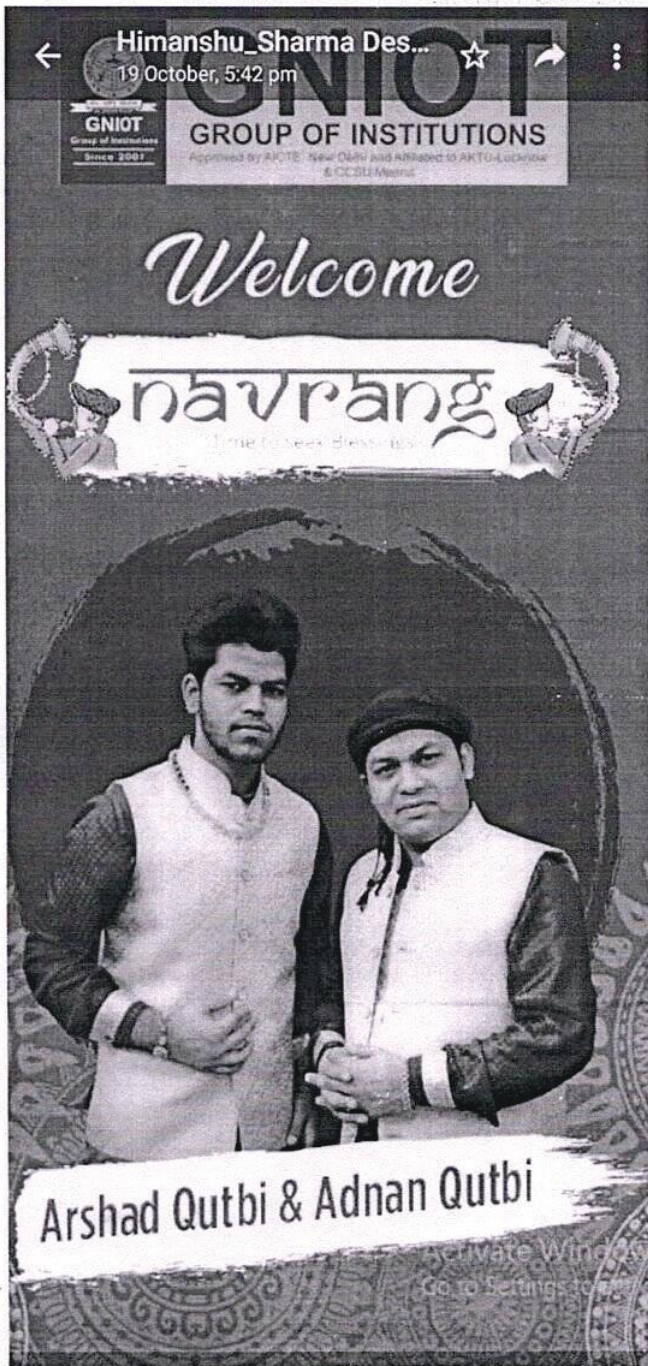
A report on Navrang (29 Oct, 2018)

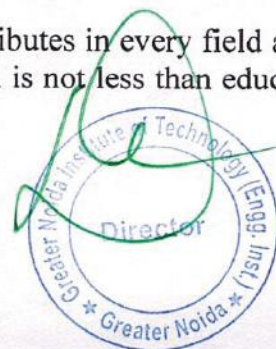
“Education is the only key to empower girls.”

Hod, IT Dr. Manoj Singhal Sir shared his views regarding the Girl Education and Hygiene and inspired students to promote it at their best.

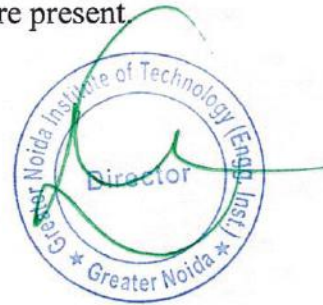
