


PLANTAION DRIVE (2018)








Outcome of the Event:



Several villagers in the fringes of Rampur Bhangar, Jewar Block, Greater Noida are open defecating. This lack of proper sanitation leads to negative impacts in the health of public, and may also lead to various diseases such as typhoid, diarrhea, intestinal infection, cholera and many others. The nearby water sources are also getting polluted because of the defecation done near it.

The need arises because of lack of infrastructure, unsafe and risky toilets which are poor in quality and lacks privacy, some of the villagers prefer being in nature or are not aware of the adverse effects because of it. Therefore, the need of the hour is to provide better facility as much as possible to reduce open defecation and educate them about the adverse effects.

The villagers are to be provided with type of toilet that treats human waste by biological process and reduces the fecal contamination. The role of Greater Noida Institute of Technology was to analyze the area where maximum open defecation is observed and provide bio-toilets near them. A team of faculty and students reached the villagers and make them aware about the adverse effects of open defecation, the benefit of using bio-toilet.

Here, the human waste or excreta goes to the bio digestor tank which is filled with one third of the bacteria. The anaerobic bacteria decompose the human waste and converts it into CO₂, methane gas and water. The surface of the tank is increased by providing modules or chambers in the digestor to increase the digestion. The grey water coming as an effluent can be used for irrigation purposes.

Important Dimensions, Volume of Bio-digester Tank & Materials required: 1. Length - 1150 mm 2-Width - 720 mm, 3. Height - 540 mm 4. Total Volume of Tank - 400 liters. 5. Effective Volume of Tank - 300 liters.

The main parts of the Bio digester tank consist of:

- 1. Tank with partition walls inside the tank.
- 2. Poly grass mats for protection of bacteria inside the walls.
- 3. Ball valve with handle for operation for making toilet direct dischargein case of choking.



ESSAY ON WASTE MANAGEMENT



The improper disposal of municipal waste has a serious and dangerous impact on a wide range of areas. Garbage thrown in the street or in open spaces creates a public health hazard, while waste dumped near rivers, lakes and streams contaminates the water supply. Rubbish that is burned in the open rather than disposed of properly creates pollution and releases toxio fumes into the environment. Non bio degradable

materials thrown into open drains make their way into the sewerage system, clogging pipelines and damaging infrastructure. The hazards posed by the dumping of untreated hospital and industrial waste are even greater, with the release of pathogens and toxic compounds posing a grave threat not just to human life but also to plants and animals. Garbage dumped in the countryside is not simply an eyesore; entire landscapes are ruined and unique habitats for flora and fauna are lost.

Prof. Shiv also highlighted the various technologies that are being used for scientifically disposing the solid waste. He discussed about sanitary landfills, incineration, and pyrolysis mainly. Further, present scenario of waste management in India was also discussed by him.


A report on Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan

PROJECT PROPOSAL

Project Title: Installation of Bio-Toilets in Jewar Block, Greater Noida

Project Objective: To design and providebio-toilets, for the villages that fall under the Jewar Block in Greater Noida for the hygiene of the villagers, as well as to provide low-cost manure for crop cultivation.

Project Justification:

- a) Problem Statement: Several villagers in the fringes of Jewar Block, Greater Noida areopen defecating. This lack of proper sanitation leads to negative impacts in the health of public, and may also lead to various diseases such as typhoid, diarrhea, intestinal infection, cholera and many others. The nearby water sources are also getting polluted because of the defecation done near it. These villages includeJunpat, Khedi, Bhogpur, Rampur Khader, RampurBhangar.
- b) Priority Needs: The need arises because of lack of infrastructure, unsafe and risky toilets which are poor in quality and lacks privacy, some of the villagers prefer being in nature or are not aware of the adverse effects because of it. Therefore, the need of the hour is to provide better facility as much as possible to reduce open defecation and educate them about the adverse effects.
- c) Proposed Approach: The villagers are to be provided with type of toilet that treats human waste by biological process and reduces the fecal contamination. It is proposed to provide 4 bio-toilets for Junpatvillage having a population of 1976 of 302 housholds.

The role of GNIOT here is to analyze the area where maximum open defecation is observed and provide bio-toilets near them. A team of faculty and students will reach the villagers and make them aware about the adverse effects of open defecation, the benefit of using bio-toilet.

Brief Plan for activities and implementation timeline: The activity can be divided into 3 categories named a) Surveying of the area to observe the area prone to open defecation, the data of 3 weeks will be taken. b) Construction of bio-toilet 5-7 days. c) Educating the villagers about the bio-toilets. The digestor tanks used here are as per the specifications provided by the IR-DRDO BIO-TOILETS. The details of which is readily available in internet. The implementation of the project may take minimum of one and half month and maximum of 3 months.

Methodology, materials & financial Resources: Here, the human waste or excreta goes to the bio digestor tank which is filled with one third of the bacteria. The anaerobic bacteria decompose the human waste and converts it into CO₂, methane gas and water. The surface of the tank is increased by providing modules or chambers in the digestor to increase the digestion. The grey water coming as an effluent can be used for irrigation purposes.

Important Dimensions, Volume of Bio-digester Tank& Materials required:1. Length - 1150 mm 2-Width - 720 mm, 3. Height - 540 mm 4. Total Volume of Tank - 400 liters. 5. Effective Volume of Tank - 300 liters.

The main parts of the Bio digester tank consist of:

1. Tank with partition walls inside the tank.

2. Poly grass mats for protection of bacteria inside the walls.

3. Ball valve with handle for operation for making toilet direct discharge in case of choking.

Financial Resources: The final price per module comes out to be Rs. 28,500. There is no availability of any other funding.


PLANTAION DRIVE (2022)

The event concluded with a pledge by all the participants to nurture and care for the planted saplings and spread awareness about the importance of trees in our surroundings.


