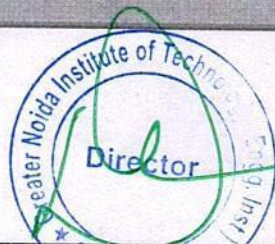

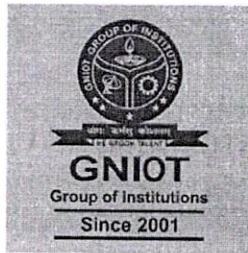

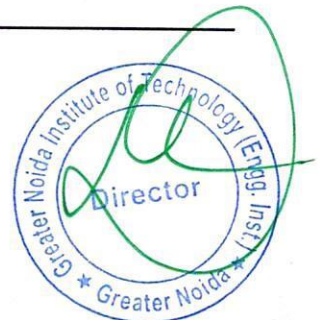

- Awareness campaign on the importance of cleanliness and hygiene.

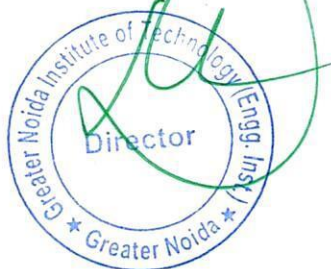
Participants:

The Event was an interactive Question and Answer session. The session was very fruitful and interactive.

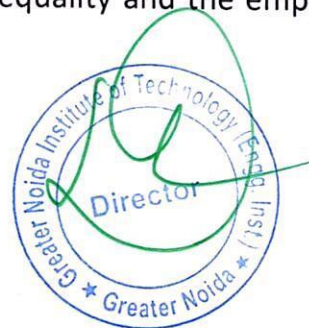

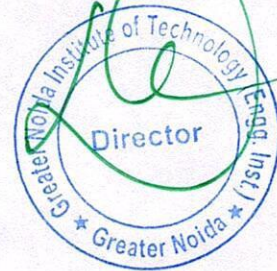
INDIAN CULTURE & WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

Report on Girls Education Conducted by Electronics and Communication Department on 11th October 2018 "If you educate a Girl you educate nation"

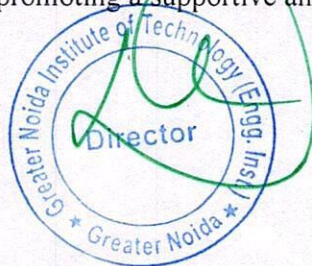

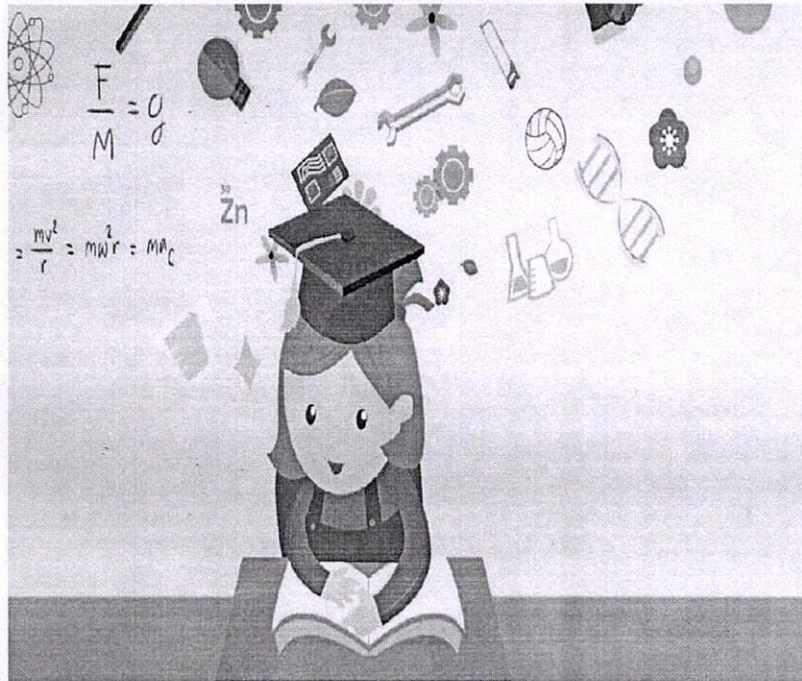
Several speakers at the occasion discussed the value of girls' education. Some famous people have said the following:


A report on Kite Flying (13 August, 2019)

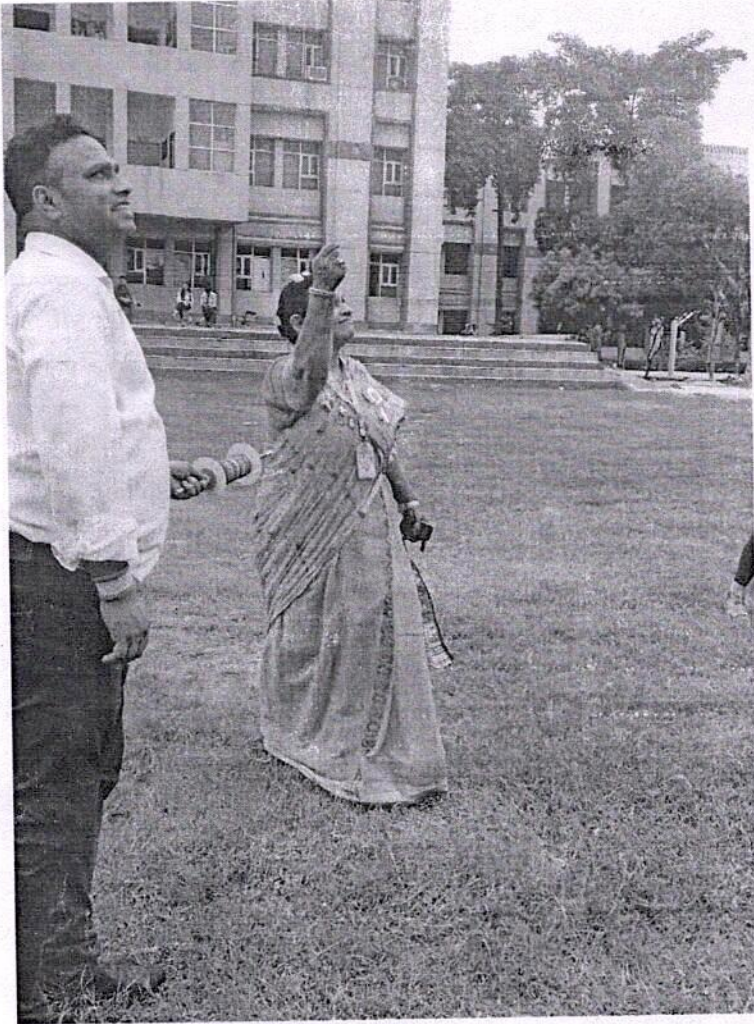
Kite-flying is an interesting tradition followed on the occasion of Independence Day in India.
