ESSAY ON WASTE MANAGEMENT




The improper disposal of municipal waste has a serious and dangerous impact on a wide range of areas. Garbage thrown in the street or in open spaces creates a public health hazard, while waste dumped near rivers, lakes and streams contaminates the water supply. Rubbish that is burned in the open rather than disposed of properly creates pollution and releases toxic fumes into the environment. Non bio degradable



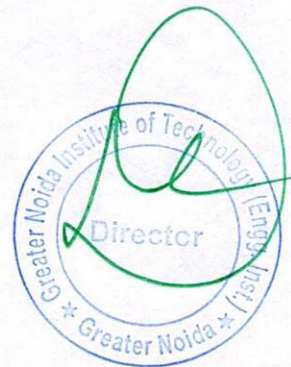
materials thrown into open drains make their way into the sewerage system, clogging pipelines and damaging infrastructure. The hazards posed by the dumping of untreated hospital and industrial waste are even greater, with the release of pathogens and toxic compounds posing a grave threat not just to human life but also to plants and animals. Garbage dumped in the countryside is not simply an eyesore; entire landscapes are ruined and unique habitats for flora and fauna are lost.

Prof. Shiv also highlighted the various technologies that are being used for scientifically disposing the solid waste. He discussed about sanitary landfills, incineration, and pyrolysis mainly. Further, present scenario of waste management in India was also discussed by him.

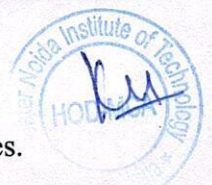
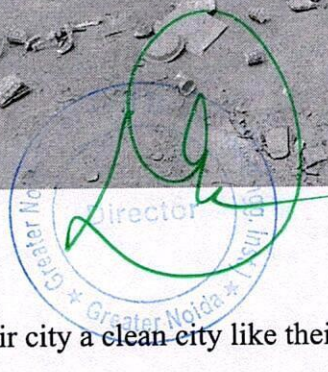
A report on Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan
