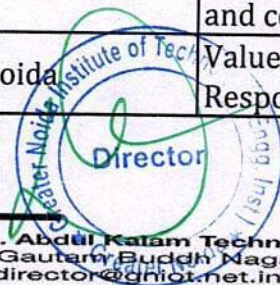

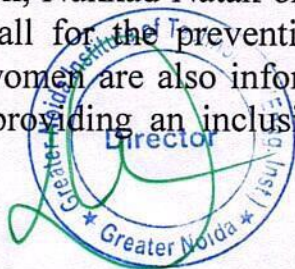

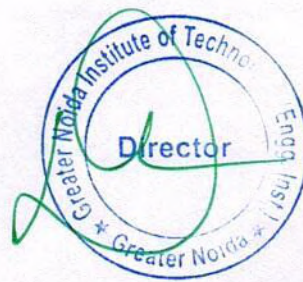
For example, Lamp lighting ceremony is one of the cultures in GNIOT, according to which every event is to be inaugurated with the blessings of goddess Saraswati. Our institute also makes sure to celebrate patriotism-based events such as Republic day and Independence day. Kite-flying is an interesting and important tradition followed on the occasion of Independence Day in India. Over the years, kites became an expression of freedom, a means to resist colonial rule. As such, today, people express their gratitude and celebrate their freedom and patriotism by flying kites, which are mostly seen hovering over rooftops and terraces. On 15 August, faculty members along with Director sir and members from the admin department participate in the kite flying competition. Furthermore, on special demand, a rally was organized on 5 August, 2022 where director sir (Dr. Dheeraj Gupta) conducted a march upto 2 km along with Indian flags in the hands. A number of slogans like Jai Jawaan Jai Kisaan were also included to raise the spirit of being Indian.

The institute also keeps tab on celebrating festivals such as Vishwakarma Day and Shivratri. These type of events are organised to light up the festival spirit in the institute which lead to happiness, unity, harmony among people. Navrang is another event which marks the promotion of cultural, regional and linguistic, as on this event, faculty members present their talent in the form of dancing, acting and singing. The performances are selected to show the diverse culture of India, e.g. dandia form from Gujrat, Laavni from Maharashtra, bhangra from Punjab and classical dance (kathak). Report on Girls Education Conducted by Electronics and Communication Department in Birondi Village: "Educate a Girl and She Will Change the World"

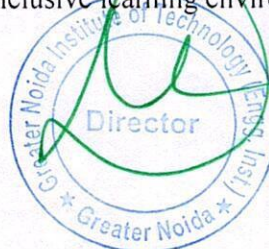

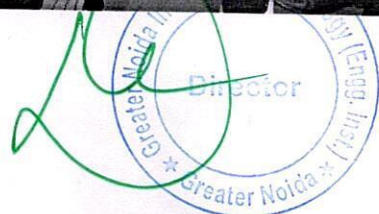


Jyoti and Sonali from IT 3rd Year also presented their views highlighting the importance of the day. The session was attended by more than 60 students and all faculty members of IT.





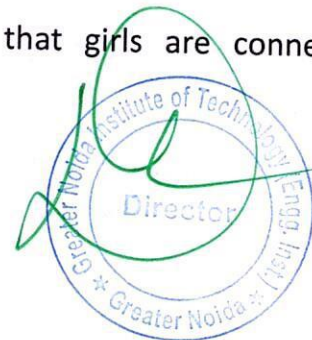
The Event was backed –up from the participant end with an interactive Question and Answer session. The session was very fruitful and interactive.

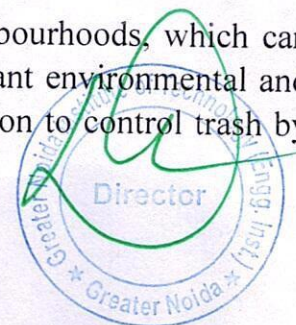
Waste Management Event Summary Report

2. Improved Water and Food Practices: Villagers became more conscious of the quality of water they consumed and took measures to access clean water sources. They also paid attention to the cleanliness and storage of food items to prevent contamination.
3. Enhanced Knowledge: Villagers gained a better understanding of the importance of hygiene maintenance in preventing diseases and promoting good health. They were more informed about proper handwashing techniques and the significance of clean water and food sources.

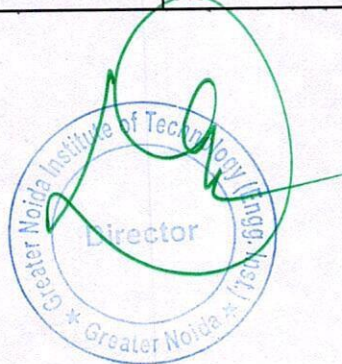
