



2. Your willingness to conduct the program.

Sanction is hereby accorded to conduct AICTE-ISTE Induction/Refresher Program on Emerging Trends in Wireless Communication during 10-12-2018 to 15-12-2018

You are requested to take steps to conduct the program subject to the following terms and conditions (as laid down by the AICTE and ISTE):

- The total budget sanctioned for the program is Rs.3,00,000/- for 40 participants for one week. Expenses must not exceed the prescribed budget under any circumstances. In case, the participants are more than 40, no additional funds will be made available by ISTE. However, if the number of participants is less than 40, the budget will be reduced accordingly under the sub-heads Boarding & lodging etc.
- 2. Please prepare an information brochure on the program containing desired information and salient features of the program inviting applications from all the institutions in your area. Not more than 20% participants from the host institutions and remaining participants will be from the nearby institutions. Preference should be given to the participants having ISTE Life Membership and those who are not members, kindly ensure and arrange to enroll them as members of ISTE before/during commencement of the program.
- 3. The fund will be released in two instalments. The first instalment (50% of the total sanctioned budget) will be released before the commencement of the program and on the receipt of acceptance letter. The second instalment will be released after the receipt of the following documents:

a. Detailed schedule of the training program

b. List of resource persons invited with full address, brief bio-data, contact details, topics etc.

c. List of participants attended the training program.

d. Copy of question paper and mark sheet for the test conducted at the end of program.

- e. Feedback of the participants with signature
- f. Photographs of the conducted events (@10 or more) of which 5 good photos in duplicate for submission to AICTE and a video CD of selected sessions.
- g. Audited statement of expenditure certified by registered and practicing Chartered Accountant firm.
- h. Two copies of proceedings

Note: The above should be countersigned by the Coordinator.

4. The expenditure under the Heads 'Honorarium to Course Coordinator' and 'Honorarium to Resource Persons' will not exceed 1% & 20% respectively of the total sanctioned grant for the program. However, overall expenditure will not be exceed the funds sanctioned for the program. Distribution of grant under different heads is as below:

5. Any change in the schedule for holding the program, change of Coordinator's name, venue and date would require prior approval, failing which the offer for the grant already issued would be treated as automatically withdrawn.

6. The certification of these programs will be done by ISTE jointly with AICTE. A test should be conducted at the end of the program and the certificates will be issued only to those participants, who qualify the test.

- 7. In case the program is cancelled, the funds shall be called back from the institute by ISTE immediately alongwith interest accrued on the amount of grant released.
- 8. Surprise visits will be planned by AICTE and ISTE during the Program. The Executive Council Member/Section Chairman/SMC Member from your State or an expert from the nearby institution may be requested by the Hqrs. to pay visit during the program in order to monitor the progress of the program. They will have discussions with the course coordinator, resource persons and the participants. They will be submitting their report to ISTE which in turn will be submitted to AICTE.
- 9. The institute should submit statement of expenditure after completion of the program duly audited by certified Chartered Accountant Firm. Institute should keep supporting bills/documents in original with them. It should be made available in verification, if required in future.

In this proposal conjunctive use of groundwater along with the surface water from a large hydraulic structures such as earth dam, etc can be carried out in a most efficient way so that sustainability must be maintained. The basic idea of conjunctive use is using surplus surface water during rainy monsoon seasons while utilising the groundwater for the period of non-availability of surface water. During the water surplus months the seepage caused near large earth dams leads to recharge of groundwater causing the groundwater table to rise. While on the other hand, depletion of groundwater occurs during the pumping season, when surface water is scarce. As the use of seepage from an earth dam to recharge groundwater is a common practice in many parts of the world, and can be an effective way to improve groundwater management and increase water security. When an earth dam is built, a portion of the stored water will naturally seep through the dam and into the underlying soil and rock formations. This seepage can contribute to the recharge of groundwater aquifers, replenishing the groundwater resources and increasing the amount of water available for extraction. Optimisation of water use from surface water and groundwater will be carried out by developing a model based on Artificial intelligence. The origin of the proposal to address the problem of conjunctive use of water is difficult to trace as it likely arises from a variety of sources including water management agencies, nonprofit organizations, academic institutions, and other stakeholders concerned about the efficient and sustainable use of water resources. Conjunctive use of water refers to the integrated management of different water sources such as surface water, groundwater, and recycled or treated wastewater, to meet the demands of various water users in an optimal manner. This approach seeks to balance the competing demands for water by different sectors (e.g. agricultural, urban, industrial, etc.) and to ensure that the available water resources are used in the most efficient and sustainable way. The problem of conjunctive use of water arises from the fact that water is a finite and increasingly scarce resource, and that traditional approaches to water management that rely on a single source of water (e. g. surface water or groundwater) are often inadequate to meet the growing demands for water from different sectors. The conjunctive use of water aims to address this problem by improving the efficiency and sustainability of water use and helping to ensure that water resources are managed in a way that meets the needs of all stakeholders

Assess the current situation of water availability, demand, and utilization in India, with a particular
focus on the regions facing acute water scarcity and the potential for conjunctive use of surface and
groundwater in these regions.



1. Introduction

Increasing concerns over global warming due to harmful emissions from conventional power plants and gradual depletion of fossil fuel deposits have led the experts worldwide to shift their focus towards utilization of renewable energy sources (RESs) (like wind and solar energies) for power generation. These RESs possess inherent advantage of availability in abundance and are environmental friendly. The RESs when operated at low voltage/medium voltage levels in coordination with other distributed generation (DG) sources (like fuel cell, diesel engine generator, micro turbine, etc.), energy storage systems, control units, and electric loads constitute a small network that is capable enough to satisfy the power demand of its region. This small network is termed as an MG. Improved power quality, increased flexibility, reliable power supply, reduction in feeder capacity, and

reduced transmission losses are the principal advantages associated with the MGs [1]. An MG is capable of operating either in grid-connected or islanded mode. In rest of the paper, MG and islanded MG have been used interchangeably. Although the MG expedites an increased penetration of the RESs but at the same time sporadic nature of these RESs and low inertia of the DG sources installed in the MG may cause an imbalance between the power generation and load demand. Consequently, this imbalance may result in intense frequency deviation problems in the MG (especially in the islanded mode). The resulting frequency deviations degrade the power quality, thus, affecting the reliability and stability of the MG. In such a regime LFC plays an indispensable role. LFC aims at restraining the frequency deviations within some pre-specified limits by reducing the disparity between the power generation and load demand, thereby preserving the power quality, reliability, and stability of the MG. To achieve this, proper implementation of an effective LFC strategy is obligatory.



Minutes of Meeting (MoM) of meeting held between Additional Dean-Research and Development and Ph.D. faculty members on 28th March'2022

Prof. (Dr.) Vaibhav Shrivastava, Additional Dean-R&D conducted a presentation of 34 slides to provide an idea of reforming the research culture at GNIOT and tools to improve on that. Moreover, he informed the fleet of doctorates about open research funding opportunities with Science and Engineering Research Boards until 22nd April'2022 and motivated researchers to design problems for submission. The presentation started at 1.45pm and ended by 2.25pm. The highlights of the presentation of Dr. Vaibhav Shrivastava were as follows:

- Self-motivation is MUST for growth in Research.
- Categories of Research: Core and Multidisciplinary
- 3. Examples of how can anyone start?
- 4. Help from Research Cell on collaboration with National Institutes of Eminence.
- Involving Undergraduates for research problems from the conclusion of 4th semester examinations.
- 6. Involving Postgraduates for handling problems with maturity and responsibly.
- Collaborate for coupled research across departments.
- 8. Research schemes from SERB are open until 22nd April'2022 and will soon be open from UGC, DAE and AICTE.
- 9. Categories of Early Career Research for Young doctorates and Core Research Group for mature doctorates MUST be addressed by 10th April'2022 by writing an initial level of research proposal.
- 10. Research MOUs are under process with institutions like IIT Delhi, IIT Kharagpur, IIT Indore, IIT Patna, CSR Indore, DU, and DTU.

Later, Honorable Director Prof. (Dr.) Dhiraj Gupta opened the forum for discussions and suggestions in the light of elaborations by Dr. Vaibhav Shrivastava and earlier projected research targets by various departments.

- 1. Dr. Preety Verma Dhaka emphasized on need of MOU with companies in production and services to have coupled projects with them for students and faculty apart from training needed for students to understand research terms like abstract, literature review and software prezi. Also she expressed that students should start research practices from the beginning of 3rd semester of their respective program.
- 2. Dr. Shivani Dubey expressed the need of open learning resources needed in research like latex and list of projects should be made open for all students and faculty for providing them an opportunity to get themselves coupled. Also she expressed the need of plagiarism software for institution,
- 3. Dr. Kirti highlighted the need of in-house FDPs and workshop
- 4. Dr. Vivek Gupta mentioned about sponsoring IEEE conference and registration fee for students and
- 5. Dr. Anil Dubey expressed the need of spectrum analyzer costing around Rs.3.5Lacs for better teaching
- 6. Dr. Shailee Garg expressed the need to purchase basic VLSI tools for the better teaching led research

7. Dr. Ravinder Kumar expressed the need of in-house teaching/research talks by all faculty members for familiarizing the background of respective research areas.

8. Dr. Avinash Ravi Raja expressed about fading faculty retention in order to achieve research goals as a primary concern. The research problems initiated by one faculty member in a particular semester may not last even a year for a student due to this poor retention rate.

9. Dr. Moti Singh suggests to seriously work on the research culture.

10. Dr. Santosh K. Srivastava mentioned the need of research methodology teaching at lower levels of academic programs for providing students a flavor of research.

11. Dr. Anuranjan Mishra mentioned on stressing the innovation part then moves to find research problems and suggested a method of asking students about their routine problems in daily life and start from there to develop a research problem.

12. Dr. Deepak Kr. Verma wondered that students have serious challenges on simple understanding of formatting style, plagiarismethics, before they can be prompted to take up a research problem by reading a paper. They can be given a mini project kind of platform before going to a research paper.

13. Dr. ShwetaTyagi mentioned about much needed platform for exploring possibilities of coupled research and invited everyone to couple on some ongoing research problems by her.

14. Dr. B.S.Chauhan expressed challenges on the part of non-availability of PhD students as he himself guided a student before 4 years and due to this inconsistency it is extremely difficult to remain motivated for research.

15. Dr. R. K. Sharma expressed the desire to seriously work on three issues: team formation+basic infrastructure support+research culture.

16. Dr. Vijay Shukla expressed his recent joining of the GNIOT family and found himself excited about efforts on establishing research culture.

17. Honorable Director-QARM Prof.(Dr.) Rajesh Pathak expressed that problems and solutions go handin-hand, there is need to take a right approach, NEP emerges as a solution that mentions serious contribution of research practice in wholesome growth of a student in its interdisciplinary format. He suggested that lets start treating our self as a student and soon we can enrich our self.

18. Dr. Ramveer Singh expressed his concern on how to maintain balance between quantity and quality of the research we aim to publish. As for various accreditation processes we are already lagging on numbers part.

19. Dr. Dinesh Sharma invited everyone to couple with him on his research problems of Fluid Dynamics.

20. Dr. Jai shankar Prasad expressed his opinion on involving 6th semester students for research level problems as they have been already occupied with innovation based problems and provide them certificates of appreciation at a common platform.

21. Dr. Hare ram Singh agreed with the idea of research coupling from 2nd year onwards

22. Dr. Rajeev stressed upon establishment of a research cell and a dedicated team referring to the example of CPRC, collaboration with national research centers, incentives for students and faculty members, balance between teaching and research, effective coordination by Additional Dean-R&DGreater N

23. Dr. Amit Kr. Agarwal expressed the need of consultancy projects and immediate action plan to address

24. Dr. Iqbal A Khan suggested that around 30% students groups must be provided interdisciplinary research problems, actual work balance with research, undergraduate research practice is already common in foreign universities at sufficient early level as immediately on joining a program.

- 1. Departments should immediately address projected research targets with the help of Research Cell led by Dr. Vaibhav Shrivastava.
- Dr. Vaibhav will design and monitor the execution process of projected research targets with the help of a research cell team whose members will be announced shortly.
- 3. Existing 2nd year batch moving towards the conclusion of their academic year, MUST be provided expected research targets by scheduled research teams/groups before they leave for their homes for summer break.
- All doctorate faculty members MUST try to write research proposals for submission to SERB before 10th April'2022 so that editing can be done for final submission to SERB before 22nd April'2022.
